HORSE RIDING

There are thousands of acres of surrounding public lands available for riding horses. However, much of it is steep terrain or thick vegetation and trees with many obstacles. Those same lands have hundreds of miles of logging roads closed to motorized vehicles which make good horse trails. Using the roads, combined with some cross-country travel provide some loop riding opportunities.

Trailhead facilities are located at the following locations:

- ✓ Pyramid Pass -- No water.
- ✓ Lodgepole Creek
- ✓ Monture Creek
- ✓ North Fork Blackfoot.
- ✓ West Fork Clearwater

Trailheads with no facilities

- ✓ McCabe Creek
- ✓ Dunham Creek. Difficult turnaround with trailer.
- ✓ Lake Elsiná.. At end of road.
- ✓ Spook Lake-Game Ridge. From Vaughn Cr Rd #4337.
- ✓ Blackfoot-Clearwater Wildlife Management Area
- ✓ Marshall Creek. Park at level area near the mouth of lake.
- ✓ Richmond Ridge. Park at Jct Rd # 4353 and 720.
- ✓ Rice Ridge. Park at junction of Road #720 and 4369
- ✓ Road To The Buffalo Trail. From Ninemile Prairie Rd.
