Snowmobile Trails around Seeley Lake Country

Archibald Loop Snowmobile Trail

Archibald Loop Snowmobile Trail begins at West Side Bypass Road 2190, Junction S, and continues on Archibald Loop Road 2192 to Junction P, Q, and R, then back to Road 2190 and Junction S. Good family trail. Heavy snowmobile traffic at times

Length: 7 miles round trip; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: West Side Bypass Road 2190. Trail Ends: Loop

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Archibald Loop Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Auggie Cutoff Snowmobile Trail

Auggie Cutoff Snowmobile Trail begins at Auggie cut-across Road 436, Junction B, then continues to Rice Ridge Road 720, Junction E. This trail serves multiple uses. Watch for signs

Length: 3 miles one way; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Road 436. Trail Ends: Rice Ridge Road 720

Directions: Auggie Cutoff Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley

Camp Creek - Rice Ridge Snowmobile Trail

Camp Creek - Rice Ridge Snowmobile Trail begins just south of milepost 22 on Highway 83 and continues on Road 4362 to Rice Ridge Road 720 at Junction F (Route 4). Access to Rice Ridge and Holland Lake in spring when snow has melted on lower trails. Not groomed on a regular basis

Length: 4 miles one way; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Highway 83, just south of milepost 22. Trail Ends: Rice Ridge Road 720

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Camp Creek - Rice Ridge Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Cottonwood - Rich Ranch Snowmobile Trail

Cottonwood - Rich Ranch Snowmobile Trail begins at Lower Cottonwood Road 9976, junction with Cottonwood Lakes Road 477, Junction V. It continues to Rich Ranch. This is a good family trail. Seeley Lake to Rich Ranch via Routes 1 and 13 is 11 miles one way

Length: 2 miles one way; easiest trail rating

Trail Begins: Lower Cottonwood Road 9976. Trail Ends: Rich Ranch

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Cottonwood - Rich Ranch Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Double Arrow Lookout Snowmobile Trail

Double Arrow Lookout Snowmobile Trail begins at County Road 69 at the junction with Snowmass Drive, 2 miles from Highway 83 to Road 696. It leads up to Double Arrow Lookout. This is an excellent family trail. There is a scenic view of Swan Range and

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Clearwater Valley. There is heavy snowmobile traffic at times. This trail is not groomed on a regular basis

Length: 3 miles round trip; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: County Road 69.Trail Ends: Double Arrow Lookout

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Double Arrow Lookout Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

East Morrell - Blind Canyon Snowmobile Trail

East Morrell - Blind Canyon Snowmobile Trail begins at the Seeley Creek Trailhead. It travels to Road 467, Junction T, then to Road 4378 to Junction U and continues back to trailhead on Road 477. It is a good family trail but watch for detours at bridge site (no bridge). Not groomed

Length: 13 miles round trip; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Seeley Creek Trailhead. Trail Ends: Road 477

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: East Morrell - Blind Canyon Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Fawn Creek - Archibald Snowmobile Trail

Begin at Archibald Loop Road 2192, Junction Q to Fawn Creek Road 4349, Junction L. Connecting trail between Route 8B and 9

Length: 2 miles one way; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Archibald Loop Road 2192.Trail Ends: Route 8B

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Fawn Creek - Archibald Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Fawn Creek - Placid Creek Hookup Snowmobile Trail

Fawn Creek - Placid Creek Hookup Snowmobile Trail begins at Fawn Creek Road 4349, Junction M, and connects with Placid Creek Road 349, Junction N. This is a good family trail. Not groomed on a regular basis

Length: 5 miles one way; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Fawn Creek Road 4349.Trail Ends: Placid Creek Road 349

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Fawn Creek - Placid Creek Hookup Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley.

Gold Creek Snowmobile Trail

Gold Creek Snowmobile Trail begins at Road 9974, Junction O, and continues to Road 4341, and then to Road 126. Not groomed on a regular basis. Watch for drifts

Length: 28 miles one way; most difficult trail rating. Trail Begins: Road 9974.Trail Ends: Road 126

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Gold Creek Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Holland Lake Snowmobile Trail

Holland Lake Snowmobile Trail begins at Clearwater Loop Road 4370, then takes the connection trail to Road 9814 and then to Owl Creek Road 9558. Seeley Lake to Holland Lake is 45 miles one way via Routes 1, 3, 4 and 15

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Length: 7 miles one way; more difficult trail rating. .Trail Begins: Clearwater Loop Road 4370. Trail Ends: Holland Lake

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Holland Lake Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Lake Elsinia Snowmobile Trail

Lake Elsinia Snowmobile Trail begins at Fawn Creek Road 4349, Junction K, then connects to Elsinia Road 465, Junction M, all the way to Lake Elsinia. Watch for drifts

Length: 13 miles one way; more difficult trail rating

Trail Begins: Fawn Creek Road 4349. Trail Ends: Elsinia Lake

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Lake Elsinia Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Lake Marshall Snowmobile Trail

Lake Marshall Snowmobile Trail travels south from Lake Marshall, Junction 1, to Mt. Henry Road 5407, Junction J. Cut across for Route 10

Length: 3.5 miles round trip; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Lake Marshall. Trail Ends: Route 10

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Lake Marshall Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Lake Marshall Loop Snowmobile Trail

Lake Marshall Loop Snowmobile Trail begins at Fawn Creek Road 4349, Junction K, and continues to Clearwater Creek Road 463, Junction H, then connects to Mt. Henry Road 5407. This is a good family trail. More difficult on Mt. Henry leg

Length: 15 miles round trip; more difficult trail rating

Trail Begins: Fawn Creek Road 4349. Trail Ends: Mt. Henry Road 5407

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Lake Marshall Loop Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Placid Creek - Jocko Snowmobile Trail begins at Placid Creek Road 349, Junction O, and continues to junction with Beaver-Finley Creek Road 9974, Junction N. This is a good family trail. Not groomed on a regular basis

Length: 6 miles one way; easiest trail rating. .Trail Begins: Placid Creek Road 349. Trail Ends: Beaver-Finley Creek Road 9974

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Placid Creek - Jocko Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Richmond - Clearwater Loop Snowmobile Trail

Richmond - Clearwater Loop Snowmobile Trail begins at Rice Ridge Road 720, Junction C, to Road 667, then connection trail at Junction G, to Road 671, 17594 and 17593, then to Road 4353 and Clearwater Road 4370. Scenic, view of the Swan Range. Watch for drifts

Length: 20 miles round trip; most difficult trail rating

Trail Begins: Rice Ridge Road 720. Trail Ends: Loop

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

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Directions: Richmond - Clearwater Loop Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Richmond - Marshall Hookup Snowmobile Trail

Richmond - Marshall Hookup Snowmobile Trail begins at Richmond Saddle Road 667, Junction G, and continues to West Fork Clearwater Road 552, then to West Fork Crossover Road 9973, and then to Lake Marshall Road 463, Junction H. Good Family trail. Use caution at the highway crossing

Length: 11 miles round trip; more difficult trail rating

Trail Begins: Richmond Saddle Road 667. Trail Ends: Lake Marshall Road 463

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Richmond - Marshall Hookup Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Sawyer Creek - Rice Ridge Snowmobile Trail

Sawyer Creek - Rice Ridge Snowmobile Trail begins at milepost 20, Highway 83 and continues on Road 685 to Rice Ridge Road 720 at Junction D (Route 3). Access to Rice Ridge and Holland Lake in spring when snow has melted on lower trails. Not groomed on a regular basis

Length: 7 miles one way; easiest trail rating. . Trail Begins: Highway 83, milepost 20. Trail

Ends: Rice Ridge Road 720

Slippery John Snowmobile Trail

Slippery John Snowmobile Trail begins at Slippery John Road 2191, Junction P, and continues to Beaver Creek Road 9974, Junction O. This trail connects to Route 7 and 14

Length: 3.5 miles round trip; easiest trail rating. . Trail Begins: Road 2191. Trail Ends:

Junction with Trail 7

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: Slippery John Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

West Morrell - Rice Ridge Loop Snowmobile Trail

West Morrell - Rice Ridge Loop Snowmobile Trail begins at Seeley Creek Trailhead to West Morrell Road 4353, then Rice Ridge Road 720 at Junction C to Road 4361, Junction E (Route 3 A) to Road 4353 to Junction B and then back to the trailhead. Scenic, but watch for drifts. Overlooks Morrell Falls, Mission Mountains, Swan Range, Clearwater River and lakes

Length: 30 miles round trip; more difficult trail rating

Trail Begins: Seeley Lake Trailhead. Trail Ends: Loop

Area Map: Seeley Lake Area Snowmobile Trails

Directions: West Morrell - Rice Ridge Loop Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

Westside Bypass Snowmobile Trail

Westside Bypass Snowmobile Trail begins at Seeley Lake West Side Road 2190, and continues to Archibald Loop Road 2192, Junction R (Route 8B). This is a good family trail, and has scenic views

Length: 3 miles one way; easiest trail rating. . Trail Begins: Seeley Lake West Side Road

2190. Trail Ends: Route 8B

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Directions: Westside Bypass Snowmobile Trail is located out of Seeley Lake.

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
