Recreation Opportunity Guide

SNOWSHOE -- Seeley Slough.

Unmarked area north of Seeley Lake.. Level terrain through meadows and wetlands. Intersperced willow/alder thickets, lodgepole/spruce timber stands and quaking aspen. Occasionally tracked by snowmobiles..

Difficulty: Easiest

Directions: From Visitor Center north on Hwy 83 approximately four miles to Seeley Lake Ranger Station on left. Follow Canoe Trail to bird blind. Explore the open areas, through thickets and in the trees north of the lake between the highway and the river. CAUTION: Clearwater River often has unsafe ice.
